OREGON MILITARY HALL OF FAME
NOMINATION GUIDELINES

The nomination form for the Oregon Military Hall of Fame provides space for only minimal factual information about the individual being nominated. Nominators should attach to the form a short summary of not more than one page (typed or computer composed, if possible) giving the reasons why the nominee should be one of those selected from among all nominations received. This summary may be either in text form or it may simply be a listing of reasons for the nomination.

The selections will be based upon two factors:

- 1) The military record of the individual – to include heroic or leadership action, principal awards received, military innovations, etc., **and**
- 2) A civilian record of public or patriotic service – to include civic work, patriotic projects or events, service to veterans, projects influencing or motivating youth, helping the handicapped, community improvements, leadership positions, etc.

In each of the above cases, either military or civilian, the specific role of the nominee should be emphasized. The selection committee is not looking simply for personality profiles but for public and patriotic service which benefit our state, our nation, and our people. Nominee should either be a native of Oregon or individual who has spent a major portion of their life in Oregon. Both living and deceased nominees will be considered.

Clippings from publications, award citations, and letters of recommendation are optional but serve to provide evidence of the achievements of the nominee. However, they should not be considered as a substitute for the nomination. When submitting attachments, they should be copies and not originals, since they will not be able to be returned.

Military rank of the nominee should be shown. However, military rank is **not** a deciding factor. Past recipients have come from virtually all ranks, both enlisted and officer.

Nominations are due no later than December 31 of the current calendar year. Mail the nomination(s) with attachment(s), to the Oregon Hall of Fame Committee, Remembering America's Heroes, at the address shown above.
